

Optimum Business Account Center



An Optimum ID is your key to our services. To take full advantage of your Optimum Business services, you and your employees will need an Optimum ID or unique username. Creating Optimum IDs to access the Optimum Business Account Center is easy. The first ID created is the Account Manager ID (Primary ID). It provides administrative access to all the services and features in the Optimum Business Account Center, such as managing phone features including Rollover Hunting and Time-of-Day Forwarding, delegating management roles to employees, and even paying the bill.



The Account Manager ID may have been created by our technician at the time of installation. If so, you can sign in now at **optimum.net/business**.



If the Account Manager ID was not created for you, you can create one online at **optimum.net/newid** and simply follow the easy online instructions. To get started, you will need to be connected to the Internet from your Optimum Business service location. You can find your Optimum Business account number on your bill, on the Optimum Business work order that was left by the technician at the time of installation, or on your Sales Order Confirmation. Once your ID is created, log in at **optimum.net/business**.

Account & Billing



Get help managing your account or paying your bill.

Your Bill

To view your bill, go to business optimum.net and sign in. Click "MY ACCOUNT" in the navigation at the top of the page.

Here you'll see a snapshot of your current bill including amount due, due date, last payment received and your billing period. For more details on your bill, you can click "View Statements" to see your current and past statements from the last 12 months. You can also download and print your statements by clicking on the Statement Date.

Paperless Billing

Go Paperless and simplify your life. Instead of a mailed paper statement, you'll automatically receive an email with a link to your bill each month. You'll save time, money, and help the environment.

Enroll

- 1. Go to business.optimum.net. If you're not logged in, you'll first be prompted to enter your Optimum ID and password.
- 2. Once logged in, place your cursor on "MY ACCOUNT" and click "Pay My Bill."
- 3. Click "Manage Status" from the navigation on the left side of the page.
- 4. Enter your Email address where you'd like to receive notification of your bill.
- 5. Read the Terms of Service. If you agree, select "I agree" and click "Register."

Bill Payment Options



For your convenience, Optimum offers a variety of payment options.

Online

business.optimum.net: Visit business.optimum.net and login with your Optimum ID. Once logged in, click on "MY ACCOUNT" in the top navigation. You will be able to pay your bill online at no additional charge.

Auto Pay: Allows an automatic debit to be made each month to a debit/credit card or checking account.

- 1. Go to business.optimum.net. If you're not logged in, you'll first be prompted to enter your Optimum ID and password.
- 2. Once logged in, place your cursor on "MY ACCOUNT" and click "Pay My Bill."
- 3. Click "Automatic Payment" from the navigation on the left side of the page.
- 4. Complete the "Payment Information" to enroll

Your Bank's Website: Access your bank website and add Optimum as a payee.

Phone

Automated Phone System: For no fee, call 1-866-213-7456 and follow the phone prompts to make a payment by check or credit card.

Customer Service Representative: For a \$10 fee, call between the hours of 8am - 8pm, and follow the phone prompts to speak with a live representative to make a payment by check or credit card. Local phone numbers can be found on the phone list page.

Mail

Remittance Center: Mail your payment (check or money order) to the "remit to:" address on your bill stub. Please make checks payable to Optimum.

Include the remittance slip that came with your bill along with a check or money order payable to Optimum. If you don't have the remittance slip and wish to mail your payment, you can find the mailing address here.

In-Person

Optimum Store: Pay at any Optimum Store location by cash, check, money order, or credit card. To make a payment during non-business hours, a drop box is available at many locations. Dropbox payments can take 2-3 business days to process.

Payment Center: Pay by cash at authorized 3rd party payment centers. Specific payment centers may accept other payment options.

TV



One-Digit Code Programming Method—For Popular Brands

If you are using one of the brands in the list below, please use this method to program your remote. If your brand is not in the list, please go to the Auto-Search Programming Method below and follow those instructions instead.

- 1 Turn on your TV.
- 2 Press and hold the TV and SELECT buttons simultaneously until the HOME button blinks twice.
- 3 Press the TV button
- 4 Point the remote at the TV.
- 5 Press and hold down the digit key for the TV brand:

 1 = Insignia
 6 = Sanyo

 2 = LG
 7 = Sharp

 3 = Panasonic
 8 = Sony

 4 = Philips / Magnavox
 9 = Toshiba

 5 = Samsung
 0 = Visio

- 6 Let go of the digit key when the TV turns off.
- 7 Verify by pressing the TV button. This should turn the TV on and off.
- 8 Confirm that the remote is working for the TV (Power), Volume, and Mute functions.
 - If any functions are not working, try using the Auto-Search Programming Method below.

Auto-Search Programming Method

Use this method if the one-digit code method does not successfully program the remote:

- 1 Turn on the TV.
- 2 Press and hold the TV and SELECT buttons simultaneously until the HOME button blinks twice.
- 3 Press and hold down the **SELECT** key while pointing the remote at the TV.
- 4 Let go of the SELECT key when the TV turns off.
- 5 Verify by pressing the **TV** button. This should turn the TV on and off.
- 6 Confirm that the remote is working for the **TV** (Power), **Volume**, and **MUTE** functions.
 - \cdot If any functions are not working, try using the Four-Digit Programming Method that can be found at optimum.net/remote.

Changing the Volume Controls

Once you program the remote to control TV, it will automatically control the TV's volume and mute functions as well. If you want to program the remote to control the volume on the cable box instead:

- 1 Press and hold the TV and SELECT buttons until the HOME button blinks twice.
- 2 Point the remote at the cable box and press the VOL-(volume down) button.
 Note: To return to original state, program the remote using the previous instructions.

You may also need to set the cable box's volume control to variable, by following the steps below.

- 1 Press **Settings** (icon next to PAGE +) button twice to access the **Full Settings** menu.
- 2 Scroll to **Audio** and press **SELECT**.
- 3 Scroll to Volume Control and press SELECT.
- 4 Scroll to Variable and press SELECT.

TV



Optimum TV remote with optional DVR function



- 1 Turns your TV on and off
- 2 Turns your cable box on and off
- 3 Displays or exits the main menu
- 4 Shows or changes settings
- 5 Displays or exits DVR menu
- 6 Displays programs guide
- 7 Selects a highlighted option
- 8 Displays program information
- 9 Exits screens or stops playback
- 10 Returns to live TV
- Records programming
- 12 Replays the last few seconds of a recorded program
- 13 Cycles through channels marked as favorites
- 14 Tunes to the last channel watched

Getting Started with Your PRO WiFi Portal

- You will receive an Account Activation email from noreply@alticebusiness-wifi.com after the successful installation of PRO WiFi at your business. This allows you to start the set up of your PRO WiFi portal.
- 2 Use the "Click here" link in the email.

 This will take you to the portal, where you can activate your account.
- Enter your Business ID,
 included in your Account Activation email, and click "Sign In."
- 4 Edit your User Name, if you would like, and create a password.
- 5 Accept the Terms & Conditions and then click "Activate Account."
- You will then receive an email for your Account Activation Confirmation after your account has been activated.
- Use the "Click here" link in the email to log into the portal using the user name and password you created in the previous steps.

Now start customizing your splash page, creating campaigns, and setting up your Guest and Private networks.

Create Splash Page

Customize your splash page, which is the first page guests will see when they log into your guest WiFi network.

- 1. Go to the PRO WiFi Portal, then click "Guest WiFi."
- 2. Click "Theme" then "Customize this template."
- 3. Here you will find a link to upload a background image, business logo and other tools to customize the look and feel of your splash page.

NOTE: After uploading a new background image, the image must be saved to take effect. Do so by clicking the floppy disk in the top right corner.

Test Splash Page

Turn on/off, edit, remove and test splash pages you have created.

- 1. Go to the PRO WiFi Portal, then click "Guest WiFi."
- 2. Click "Theme" then "Manage Splash."
